The Flint Public Art Projects Mural Project has turned Flint into a city-wide gallery, providing everyone with the opportunity to view world class art on bricked walls, alleyways, and school buildings.

Subject of series of 10-15 mural pairings: On Union

Reach out to Michigan artists possibly: Racially and culturally diverse, Younger, lesser known, under-represented voices, women, etc. Also be selective in how we make diverse and interesting 'pairings'. Examples: Age difference, Stylistic differences: Traditional paired with more contemporary

On Union

Location: Union Street, from the Grand Traverse Bay to 14th Street

10-15 Proposed mural locations TBD with property owners on Union Street

10-30 artists

5 foot X 5 foot squares paired together from differing artists, on the subject of **Union**

Proposed Budget: 33K

1k per square/artist for mural installation, materials and travel stipend

3K for interactive piece (free-standing square frame encouraging people to share their thoughts on Union), communications, outreach, maintenance

- 12K from DDA portion of TC Arts budget
- 11K from other City portion of budget
- 10K in grants and individual contributions, possibly from property owners and other benefactors
